Previous projects completed by the POCAC include; Ferry Study, Fuel Dock Report, Public Participation Report, Port Cargoes Report, Port Renaming, Comprehensive Plan Land Use Plan Update, NewMarket Industrial Campus Development Alternatives Study, Commission Redistricting, Marine Fuel Dock Public Participation, Small Cities Program Report, and Naming Convention and Protocols.

Port Commissioner E.J. Zita, Acting Port Executive Director Rudy Rudolph and the Chair of the committee Richard Wolf interviewed applicants and recommended appointments to the Commission at the December 10, 2018 Commission meeting. Criteria for selection included being a Thurston County resident, community and economic development activities; volunteer, board or committee experience; work experience; experience or knowledge of the Port; and reasons for serving.
