## PORT COMMISSION BEGINS 2024 BUDGET PROCESS

The Port's 2024 operating and capital investment plan process begins at the Monday, October 2, 2023 Commission Work Session. As with all prior year budgets, the Port will prepare a budget that operates within its means by only allowing property tax revenue, that comes from the Port constituents, to be used towards capital projects leaving operating expenditures to be fully funded by operating revenues and some non-operating revenues excluding property taxes.
